The set of bagpipes played by Mary Murphy were designed and hand crafted by Roderick MacLellan, of MacLellan Bagpipes. They are made of African Blackwood, known for producing beautiful, rich tone. Engraved on the decorative silver portions of this set of bagpipes are the Celtic Cross and Trinity Knot. At the base of the bagpipe chanter is the Claddagh, a Celtic symbol consisting of two hands holding a heart, adorned with a crown. The hands symbolize friendship, the heart symbolizes love, and the crown symbolizes loyalty. A silver shield adorns the bass drone of the bagpipes, and reads "Made by Roderick MacLellan for Mary Murphy" and cites an old Scottish saying "*Only the Pipes Can Be Heard in Both Worlds*"
