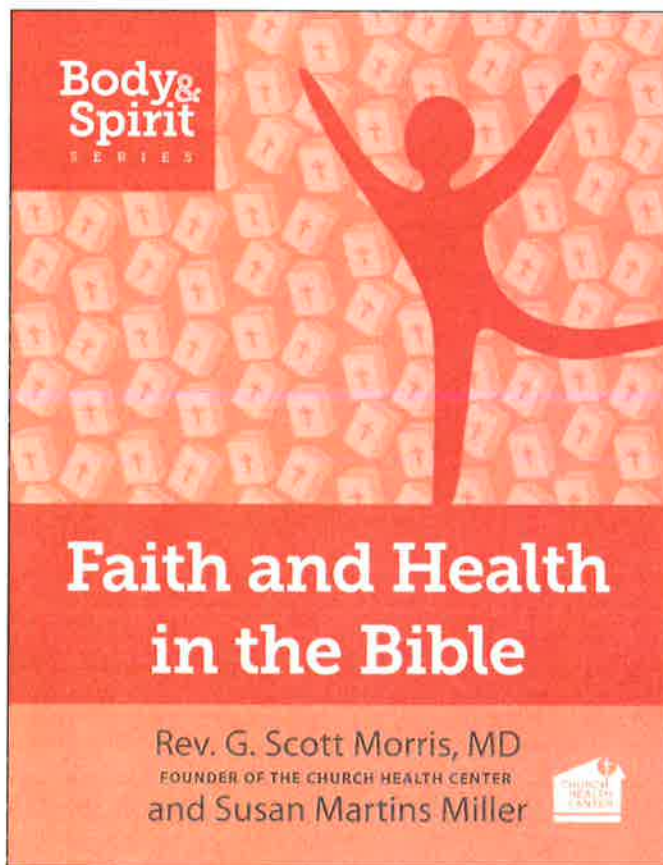
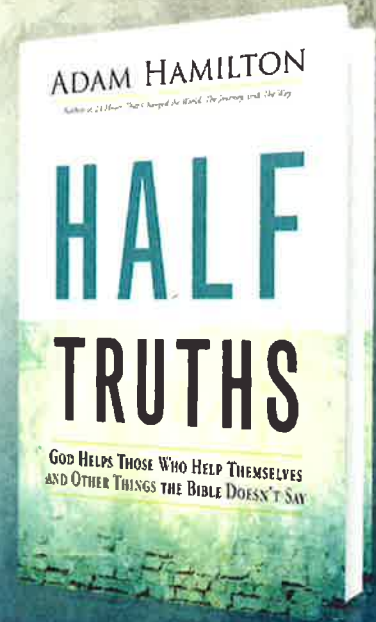

Pack for the Future Mothers' Day Project!

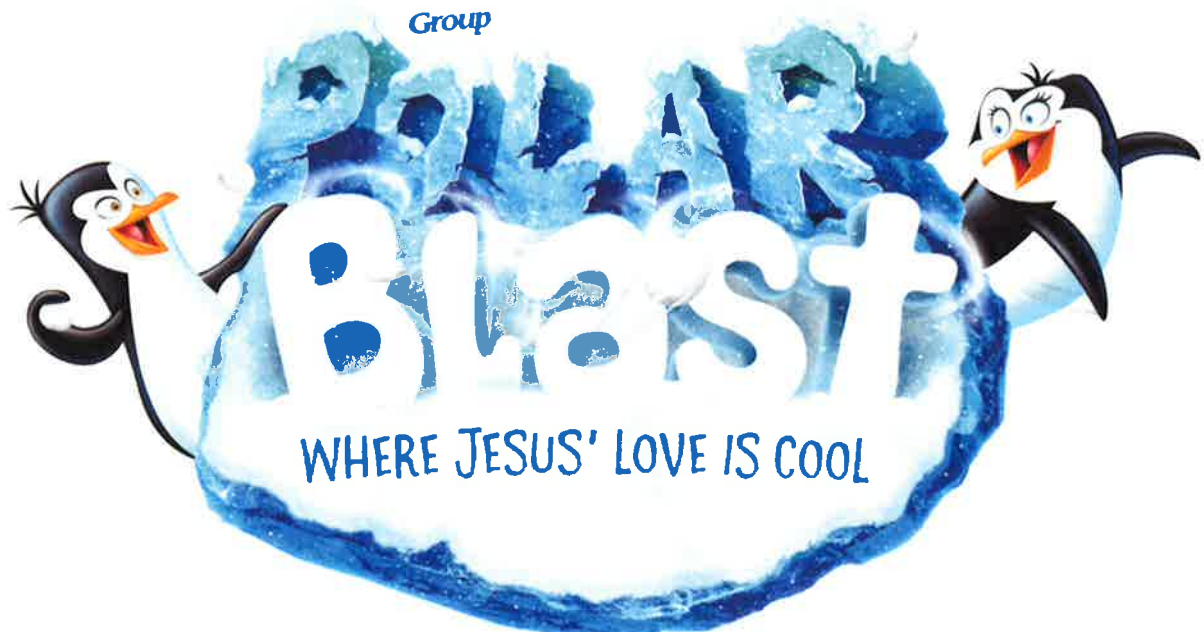
